What to know and advocate for:



Start the conversation early with your care team



Seek specialists (pelvic health, sexual health, counseling, survivorship care)



Ask how treatment may affect intimacy and body image



Ensure ongoing assessment during survivorship—not just during treatment



Access multidisciplinary support (medical, emotional, and relational)



For young women:



Sexual health concerns may be overlooked due to age or assumptions about priorities. Your quality of life matters—during and after treatment.
